CRAF Center – P. Riss – Sewer pipe in front lawn of CRAF Center compromised by root damage. Over 40 feet replaced, Thank you Carl Jock, Pat and Jeff. The new digital sign is to be installed within the next two weeks. Attendance is down, but steady. Memberships are still being purchased.

Gahagan Nature Preserve- T. Bosworth – Due to Covid-19 there are no school programs. Revenue down, trails are open 24/7. The Village of Roscommon plows the parking lot making trails accessible year around. GNP is working with Ron Alden, Village of Roscommon, in regards to the addition of recycle center property for additional parking.
